

PROPOSED REGULATIONS OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH

These regulations are being proposed in accordance with Senate Bill 17, of the 2009 legislative session, section 1 and section 2.

EXPLANATION – Matter *in italics* is new;

Section 1. Chapter 629 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 1 to 2, inclusive, of this regulation.

Destruction of Health Care Records

Section 1. Internet Website Posting of Statement Regarding Health Care Records (NRS 629. _____) The internet website posting of statement regarding health care records that includes the language used in subsection 1 (a) and (b) of Section 1 of Senate Bill 17 of the 2009 legislative session must be clearly designated as “Notice to Patients Regarding the Destruction of Health Care Records” on the website.

Section 2. Statement Regarding Health Care Records:

1. The sign required by subsection 2 of Section 2 of Senate Bill 17 of the 2009 session must:

(a) Include the language used in subsection 1(a) and (b) of Section 1 of Senate Bill 17 of the 2009 legislative session;

(b) Be at least 8 1/2 inches by 11 inches, with landscape orientation and one inch margins on all sides;

(c) Use a single typeface and standard font, with no less than 20 point characters;

(d) Be conspicuously posted at each location at which the provider performs healthcare services or at a facility that maintains health care records; and

(e) Be clearly designated as “Notice to Patients Regarding the Destruction of Health Care Records.”

2. The required written disclosure required by subsections 3 or 4 of Section 2 of Senate Bill 17 of the 2009 legislative session must include the language used in subsection (1)(a) and (b) of Section 1 of Senate Bill 17 of the 2009 legislative session and be clearly designated as “Notice to Patients Regarding the Destruction of Health Care Records.”
