IMPORTANT NOTICE – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Dear Director:

On May 29, 2009, Governor Gibbons signed into law Assembly Bill (AB) 111. AB 111 prohibits a home for individual residential care from providing accommodations to a person who does not meet the requirements for admission unless that person is related to a resident of the facility within the third degree of consanguinity. Consanguinity is a blood relationship within a family of the same descent.

This new statute becomes effective on October 1, 2009. Before October 1, 2009, you must discharge all renters and boarders residing in your facility unless they are your resident's spouse, parents, grandparents, great grandparents, children, grand children, great grand children, siblings, nieces or nephews.
