



With a score of 12, the facility would receive a score of “A” and no further action would be necessary.

If the facility were to receive a score of “B,” the administrator would need to submit an application to the Bureau for a resurvey of the facility not later than 30 days after the facility receives the placard. The fee for an application for a resurvey will be \$300 and must accompany the application. If the facility were to receive a score of “C or D,” the administrator must submit an application to the Bureau for a resurvey of the facility not later than 30 days after the facility receives the placard. The fee for an application for a resurvey will be \$500 and must accompany the application. If the facility does not submit an application for a resurvey, the Bureau may revoke the license of a residential facility.
