

# **FACILITY TO PROVIDE LABORATORY SERVICES IN THE STATE OF NEVADA**

## **Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 652 and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 652 Self-assessment and Attestation of Compliance**

Dear Health Care Provider:

The Health Division and the Bureau of Health Care Quality and Compliance have developed this document to assist Laboratory Directors in assessing how their facility meets the statutory and regulatory requirements for a Laboratory in the State of Nevada (NRS 652.070).

The self-assessment document and attestation of compliance has been established pursuant to NRS 652 and NAC 652.

Please read the enclosed directions for completing the self-assessment document, and upon completion, sign the attestation form and mail the self-assessment attestation form to the Bureau of Health Care Quality and Compliance.

1. Read the regulatory text in each box. Indicate whether or not your Laboratory meets the regulation by checking the appropriate box.

The individual signing the attestation form is indicating to the BHCQC that they have read, understand and believe they meet the applicable NRS or NAC file of requirements for the facility type for which they hold a license, and that they understand that they are expected to sustain and maintain compliance with these requirements at all times. If non-compliance is identified during an onsite visit by BHCQC survey staff there may be potential administrative sanctions imposed based on the scope and severity of the finding.
