Paul Shubert read the purpose of regulations workshop and outlined the proposed regulations in regards to Sentinel Events and NHSN.

Ann Savin – Assistant Director of Quality of Valley Health System, representing the Nevada Hospital Association (NHA) Patient Safety Committee

Ms. Savin expressed that she is in agreement with the written proposal submitted by the Nevada Hospital Association during the public workshop held in Carson City on 03/03/10.

Judy Mahoney – Quality Manager for HCA

Ms. Mahoney also agreed with the written proposal submitted by the NHA.

Gerard Marshall – Progressive Hospital

Mr. Marshall does not agree with using new forms when there are previous sentinel event forms already established. He also stated that teams of people will need to be trained on root cause analyses in order to comply with the proposed regulations.

The following are recommendations made by Mr. Marshall:

Sections 6, 7 and 8 (delete all)

Section 9 (delete all except subparagraph 6)

Section 10 (delete all of subparagraph 2 (c), modify subparagraph 4)

Section 11 (modify subparagraph 1, delete subparagraph 4)

Section 12 (delete subparagraphs 1 and 3)

Section 13 (modify subparagraph 2 (c))

Section 14 (delete subparagraphs 3 (b), 3 (d), 5, and 6, and modify subparagraph 4)

Section 15 (modify subparagraph 1 (a))

Mr. Marshall's final comments were that all of the additional reporting would have an extensive impact on small businesses and involves a quality team with multiple meetings. He believes changing the forms and making people report (due to new oversight) will be very harsh on small businesses.

Paul adjourned the workshop before 10 AM with no further questions or concerns.
