In partnership with the Nevada State Health Division, we offer FREE developmental screenings of children between **4 months and five years of age**, from experts certified to provide professional assessments.

Stop Worrying and Take Action

* All it takes is 30 minutes to complete a simple questionnaire asking questions about your child's development. Once the form is complete, it is sent to the State of Nevada, Nevada Statewide Screening Center, where an expert in child development reviews and provides confidential results in the following areas:

- * *Speech and Language development to include communication, vocabulary, word use, fluency skills, etc.*
- * *Cognitive development. Focuses on how children learn such as short-term memory, reasoning/problem solving, etc.*
- * *Social-emotional development. Social interactions and relationships with parents, caregivers and other children.*
- * *Physical development to include areas of large/gross motor development such as jumping, walking, and running. Small/fine motor development such as grasping, cutting; and hand-eye coordination.*

The screenings **DO NOT** provide a diagnosis, but rather a tool for identifying areas where additional assessment or evaluation services may benefit the child. In this situation, parents may:

-  Use your child's screening results to talk with your pediatrician or family physician
-  Receive no-cost evaluation/intervention services from the State of Nevada Early Intervention or through your local school districts
-  Find financial assistance and referral to obtain other needed services in your community
