**NEVADA PART C  
MEDICAL ELIGIBILITY DIAGNOSIS FOR NEVADA EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES**

This list is not all-inclusive.

**Chromosomal** — not a complete list and limited to syndromes associated with developmental delays such as (trisomy, deletions, Fragile X syndrome, Prader-Willi, Down syndrome, Cri-du-chat, Williams syndrome, CHARGE association, Robin sequence, Angelman's syndrome, Unbalanced Translocations, Klinefelter's syndrome). Refer to *Smiths Recognizable Patterns of Human Malformation (book)* for additional congenital malformations.

**Neuromuscular Disorders** — such as (Cerebral Palsy, Muscular Dystrophies, Hemiplegia, Myopathies, Torticollis plus other delay, Brachial Plexus with or without fractures, spinal muscular atrophy, , Diaphragmatic Hernia, Tracheoesophageal Fistula)

**Neurocutaneous Syndromes** — such as (Tuberous Sclerosis, Neurofibromatosis)

**Spinal cord injuries or defects** -- such as (Spina Bifida, Myelomeningocele, Tethered Chord)

**Arthrogryposis/Major Limb Malformations** – (includes amputations. Amniotic Band Syndrome)

**Central Nervous System** — such as (Major brain malformations, Encephalopathy, Periventricular leukomalacia, IVH Grade III or IV and Grade II with atypical tone, sensory feeding or other abnormal neurologic exam, Hydrocephalus, Traumatic Brain Injury, Shaken Baby syndrome, Bacterial or Herpes Meningitis, Infantile Spasms, Kernicterus, Neurodegenerative Disorder)

**Inborn Errors of Metabolism**

**Sensory Impairment** -- such as (**Vision** -- cortical visual impairment, cerebral visual impairment, cortical visual processing disorder, Retinopathy of Prematurity with laser treatment; ONH (Optic Nerve Hypoplasia), SOD (Septo-Optic Dysplasia) or ONH/SOD. **Hearing** -- unilateral or bilateral hearing loss; failed Newborn Hearing Screening is not a Part C referral until hearing loss is confirmed)

**Orofacial Malformations** — such as (Cleft palate, Treacher-Collins, Pierre-Robin sequence, Velo-Cardio-Facial, Goldenhar's syndrome)

**TORCH Infections** – such as (toxoplasmosis, other rubella, CMV, herpes)
