Mission of the Community Health Nursing Program

Community Nursing Clinics

- Offer affordable public health services to all community members
- Community Health Nurses in 14 primary locations and 71 satellite sites
- Operate on a sliding fee scale based on income
- Never deny services



Community Health Nursing

- Services Include:
 - Family Planning, Education, Counseling and Treatment;
 - Health Education;
 - Cancer Screening;
 - Immunizations;
 - Fluoride treatments
 - EPSDT and Lead testing;
 - Sexually Transmitted Disease Education and Counseling;
 - HIV/AIDS Counseling, Education and Rapid Testing;
 - Communicable Disease Investigation;
 - Tuberculosis Screening and Education;
 - School Health Promotion and Education; and
 - Children's Special Health Care Needs referrals
 - Public Health Preparedness
 - Substance Abuse and Mental Health Referrals
 - Autism Screening

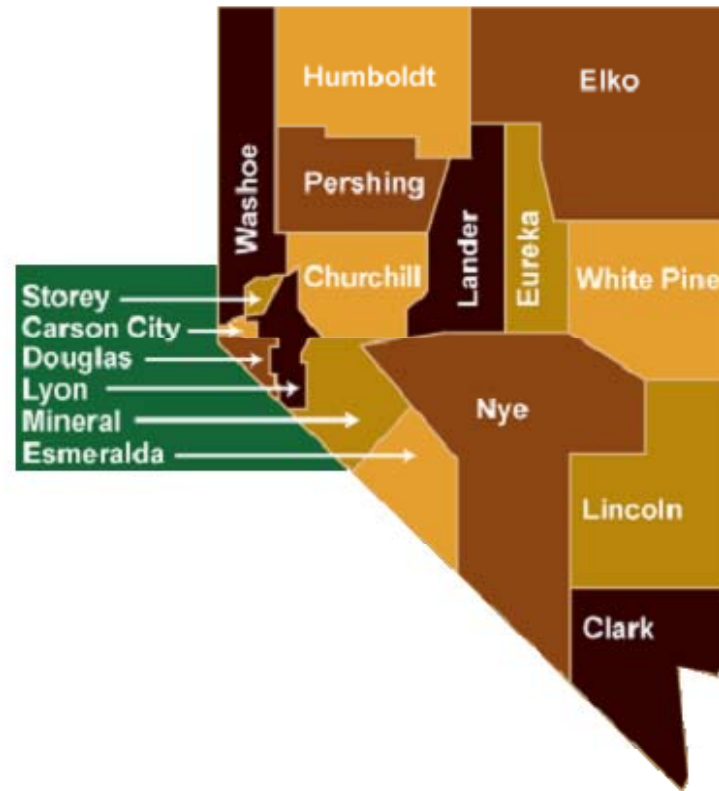

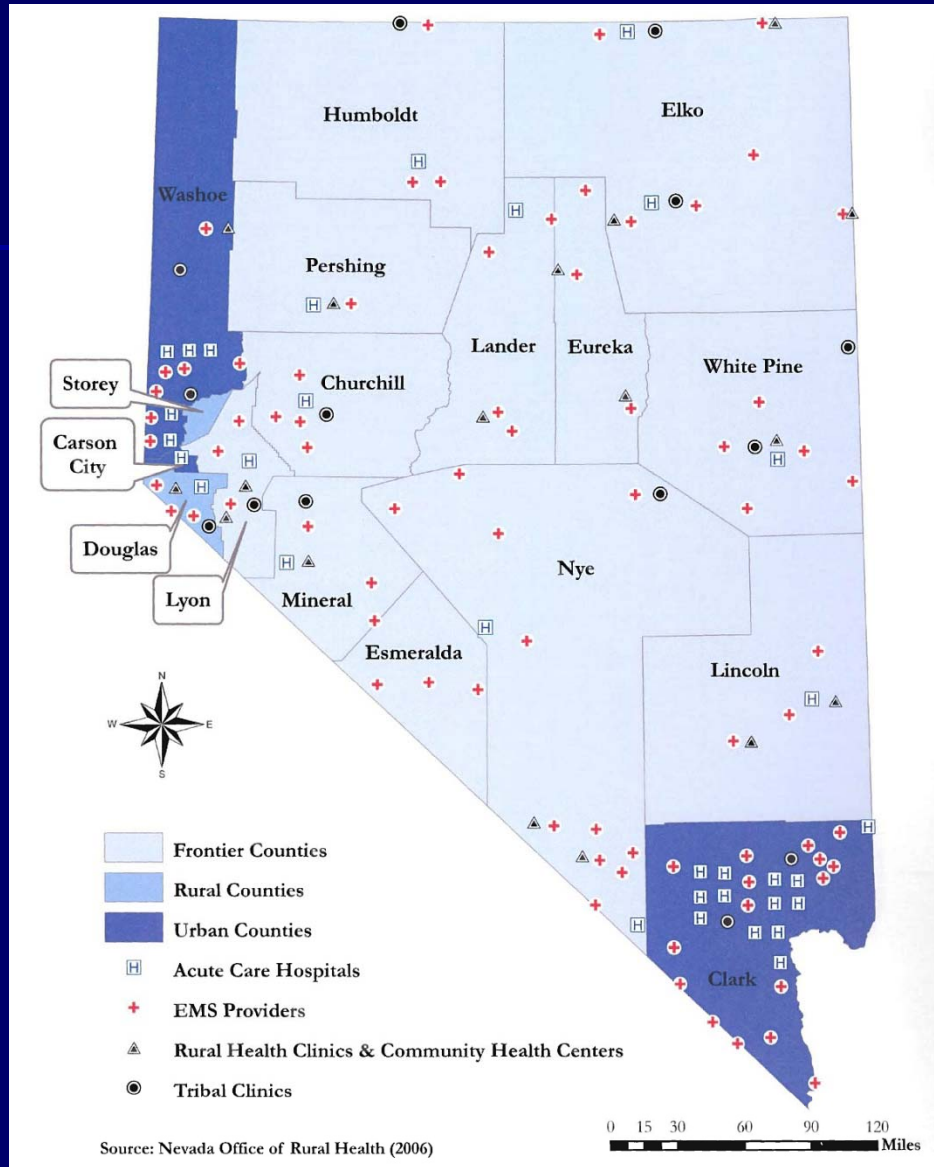
